Speaker: **NSW Police, Strike Force Raptor**

- Cut the momentum of visitation.
- There is no reflection on the licensee, this is an accord and police initiative.

- It is essential that the Liquor and Gaming Self Audit Checklist is used regularly and an incident register be kept up to date.

- Create a Drinkwise precinct through accord.
- Flemington accord has information at the stadium, train station and other venues.

- Free decals and posters supplied to all venues.
- Access to Drinkwise website for tips and advice.
- Visual affiliation with Drinkwise.
